



## BRIEF WEATHER DISCUSSION:

## **SAMPLE DAILY FORECAST**

THE NEXT COUPLE OF DAYS ARE GOING TO BE GENERALLY CALM AND QUIET BEFORE A SURGE OF ARCTIC AIR LATE THIS WEEK. A COUPLE FLURRIES MAY FALL THIS MORNING, BUT NO THREAT FOR ACCUMULATION. THE OVERCAST WE HAVE BEEN UNDER THE LAST FEW DAYS BREAKS THIS MORNING AND IT TURNS PARTLY SUNNY WITH TEMPS RISING CLOSE TO 40. TONIGHT, WE SHOULD DROP BELOW FREEZING WITH THE DECREASE IN CLOUD COVER, SO ANY WET AREAS FROM DAYTIME MELTING MAY NEED TO BE WATCHED FOR RE-FREEZE. THE NEXT BLAST OF ARCTIC AIR WILL LIKELY BRING SNOW SHOWERS AND EVEN SQUALLS TO THE AREA WED NIGHT TO THURS WITH LIGHT ACCUMULATION.

<b>WEDNESDAY</b>	Mixed sun and clouds, seasonable and windy High 40 / West winds 10-20 mph
<b>WED NIGHT</b>	Increasing clouds with snow showers arriving overnight. Light coatings possible. Low Mid 20s

<b>MEDIUM RANGE FORECAST</b>	
<b>THURSDAY</b>	Blustery and colder with occasional snow squalls and flurries. High only 30
<b>FRIDAY</b>	Partly sunny and frigid cold. High 25 - 30
<b>SATURDAY</b>	Mixed sun and clouds. High 35
