# STORM WARNING

**NOR' EASTER...** A DEVELOPING NOR'EASTER WILL BRING SOME HEAVY AND STEADY SNOW FROM LATE THIS AFTERNOON THROUGH EARLY TOMORROW MORNING. THE STORM SHOULD CONTINUE TO TAKE A TRACK FAVORABLE FOR THE PRECIP TO REMAIN ALL SNOW ACROSS THE REGION. SNOW IS LIKELY TO DEVELOP FROM SOUTH TO NORTH BETWEEN 3 AND 6 PM. THE STEADIEST SNOW IS EXPECTED TO FALL THIS EVENING FROM 6 PM – 12 AM WHERE SNOWFALL RATES COULD EXCEED 1-2 INCHES PER HOUR. ALL THREATS OF SNOW WILL TAPER OFF TO FLURRIES AROUND DAYBREAK TOMORROW.
