The day will start dry and workable before a frontal boundary approaches midday. Since yesterday, the two minor differences are the front is slightly faster but also weaker. So while the shower potential begins towards 12PM, it will be mainly light and intermittent with only around 1 hour of total rainfall before clearing in the afternoon... Conditions turn hot and humid tomorrow and the remainder of the week with afternoon thunderstorms possible both Wednesday and Friday. Neither day looks to be a washout though.

TODAY	Patchy early fog, then turning mostly cloudy. Scattered shower potential begins towards 11AM or 12PM, lasts intermittently until 4PM. Breezy. <i>Only 0.01 - 0.10" rainfall expected</i> High 74 - 78 SW winds 7 - 15 mph, shifts WNW with gusts to 25
TONIGHT	Partly cloudy. Low 65 - 69 WNW winds 5 - 10 mph
WEDNESDAY	Much hotter and more humid with a mix of sun and clouds. Scattered t-storms become likely after 2PM. High 84 - 88 (Heat Index 90 - 95) SW Winds 5 - 13 mph
WED NIGHT	A shower or storm may linger into the evening, then partly cloudy. Low near 75
