

## WEATHER ALERT

**Periods of Light Snow Late Tomorrow...** The forecast continues to look on track, with just a slightly earlier start time for snow as it arrives in the afternoon. But with very light intensity and temperatures in the mid-30s to start, we expect pavements to remain wet during the daylight hours and no initial problems. But after sunset, temperatures cool closer to 32 and snow will become steadier likely leading to pavement accumulation affecting the tail end of rush hour. Overall, the forecast remains 1.0 - 2.0" total, with the bulk of the coastal storm missing offshore. Snow ends around Midnight, though we may need to monitor the potential for a returning snow shower Saturday morning as another disturbance moves through... Conditions clear during the daytime and it will be windy.

HAZARDS		
Hazard	Threat	Description
Ice	<b>Moderate</b>	Watch for patchy freeze-up of any melted snow after storm's end
Snowfall Rate	<b>Low</b>	Snow will be light, generally < 0.5" per hour
Blowing & Drifting	<b>Low</b>	Only minor drifting late at night as winds gusts increase 15 - 25 mph

FORECAST	
Tuesday	Sunshine mixes with some late day clouds. High near 35   NW wind 8 - 15 mph
Tue Night	Partly cloudy and cold, with increasing clouds late. Low 20 - 24   Light NW winds < 8 mph
Wednesday	Turning cloudy. Flurries arrive 1 - 4 PM, becoming steadier periods of snow late. <i>Coating - 0.5" of snow (Mainly on colder surfaces, pavements likely just wet.)</i> High 34 - 38   SW winds 5 - 10 mph
Wed Night	Periods of evening light snow, ending around Midnight. Turning breezy late. <i>0.5 - 1.5" of snow (Additional accumulation likely on all surfaces. Storm Total 1.0 - 2.0." )</i> <i>Watch for patchy refreeze-up of any melted snow</i> Low 21 - 25   NW winds increase 10 - 15 mph, gusts to 20
Thursday	A returning morning snow shower possible, then partly sunny, windy and cold. <i>Just a 30% chance for a coating of snow.</i> High 35 - 40   NW winds 15 - 25 mph, gusts to 35
